What to wear and what is the weather in Berlin?

Weather Considerations

Berlin's weather in mid-October is quite cool with temperatures between 15°C and 6°C. Daytime maximum temperatures average around a cool 15°C, whilst at night 6°C is normal. Payment methods in Berlin

There is a variety of payment methods widely accepted throughout the city. A few of them are listed below.

- **Cash:** While electronic payments are widely accepted, it's still a good idea to carry some cash, especially for small purchases, street vendors, and places in less touristy areas. Euros (EUR) are the official currency in Germany.
- **Credit and Debit Cards:** Credit and debit cards, particularly Visa and MasterCard, are widely accepted in Berlin. You can use them at most hotels, restaurants, shops, and tourist attractions. However, it's a good idea to carry some cash for smaller businesses in case you encounter places that do not accept cards. There is also a possibility that American Express cards would not be accepted in many places.
